Qualifications:

- AA degree or equivalent required, preferably in social work, psychology or related field.
- Must be flexible, able to work with families in a variety of settings and time frames.
- 2 years experience providing social or educational services to low-income and culturally diverse populations. (Education beyond the AA level in a Social Service-related discipline may be substituted for 1 year of experience).
- Ability to work a flexible schedule that includes evenings or weekends.
- Bilingual English/Spanish preferred.
- A negative TB test is required as a condition of employment.
- Must have knowledge of community resources.
- Ability to relate to low-income families and their needs.
- Must work cooperatively as a member of a team.
- Must pursue additional training/professional development.

- Current certification in First Aid and CPR
- Valid California Driver's License and clear driving record.
- Ability to pass criminal record clearance.
- A current TB test and a statement of good health from a doctor are required as a condition of employment.
