The Executive/Program Director is responsible for implementation, evaluation, and achievement of the Federal Head Start Performance Standards, oversees the financial, organizational, programmatic, human resources, and serves as the connecting link between the governing bodies, staff, parents, community agencies, SFSU, and the Administration for Children and Families.

Requires an M.A. or Ph.D. degree and relevant credentials/certificates in a related field and at least 5-8 years experience in administering a community-based early childhood education and family development program. Prior senior management experience in Head Start/Early Head Start is desirable.
